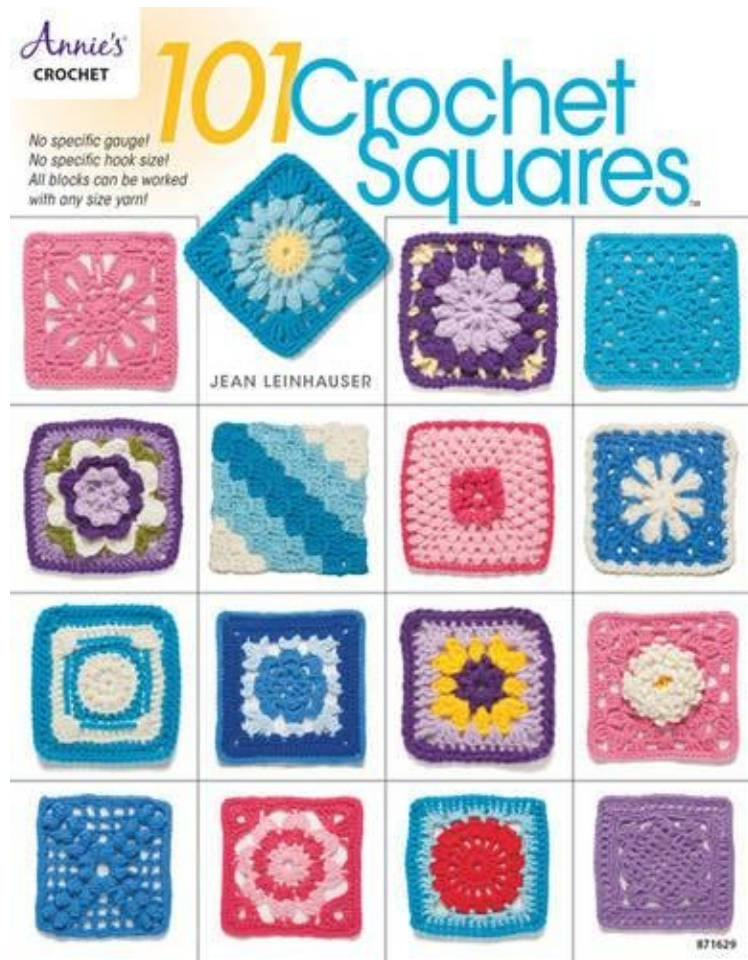

I wanted to use up some of the leftover yarn in my stash by making lap blankets for people in nursing homes, and needed some new granny square patterns. This one has plenty! Directions are fairly clear.

Unlike most crochet patterns, those in this book specify no gauge and no suggested hook size and no yarn amounts! That's because each of the 101 squares can be worked with your choice of yarn from bulky to crochet cotton to achieve just the look you want. Designs make use of up to four colors.

About the Author Jean Leinhauser was the founder of Leisure Arts and The American School of Needlework. Her crochet patterns are still being stitched today. After joining forces with Annie's, she was the first editor of Crochet! Magazine. She was also the co-owner of Crochet Partners, the oldest internet crochet discussion group. She passed away in 2011.
