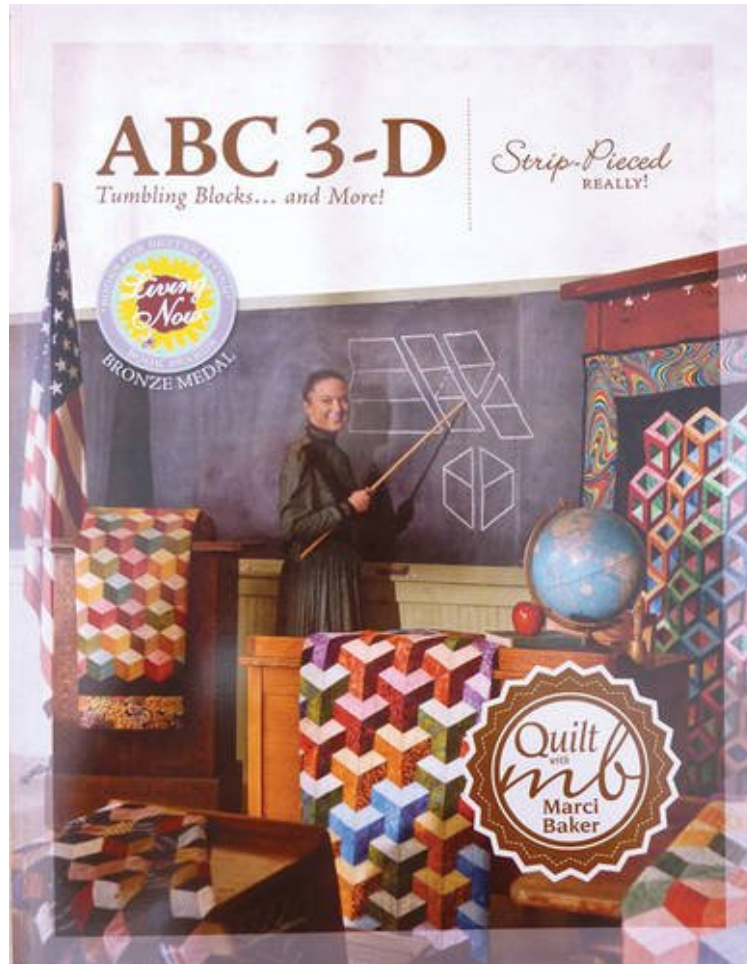

Very disorganized and poor explanations.By Lynnda GarrettI purchased this book because I had seen the videos on Youtube explaining the basic methods used in this book and they looked like something that would be easy to accomplished once the complete instructions were explained. I was very disappointed in this book. It is poorly written, vague, disorganized, and does

not clearly explain how to cut or piece the quilt together. The written instructions do not always match the pictures and this makes it more confusing. She tells you to purchase the Alicia's Attic Qtools Corner Cut to make it easier, but never explains how to use it appropriately, or how this will change the cutting or piecing of the quilt. The overall organization is poorly done as well. Part of the instructions are in the front of the book, some at the back, some are in other places as you go along. I was constantly flipping the pages back and forth, and losing my place along the way. I found this book frustrating, difficult to follow or understand, and I still have not been able to complete the simplest quilt, The Cat's Meow, which uses only the basic steps. The only reason I gave it 2 stars is because it did deliver a book with several quilt patterns as promised and someone may be able to complete a quilt, it unfortunately won't be me using this book. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. The Clearview 10 inch 60 degree triangle ruler is recommended for use with the book but the patterns call for 3 different ruler sizes. This is the least of the problems. I had such high hopes for this book and was thoroughly disappointed.
