bill lime green, I mixed the lime green with some white and painted over the lime green just enough so the sides were still the darker lime green. Next I painted the Tree Trunks face on the center of the Bill. Finally, I painted an Apple on the top on the cap, and (optional) I painted the strap on the back the lighter lime green.
