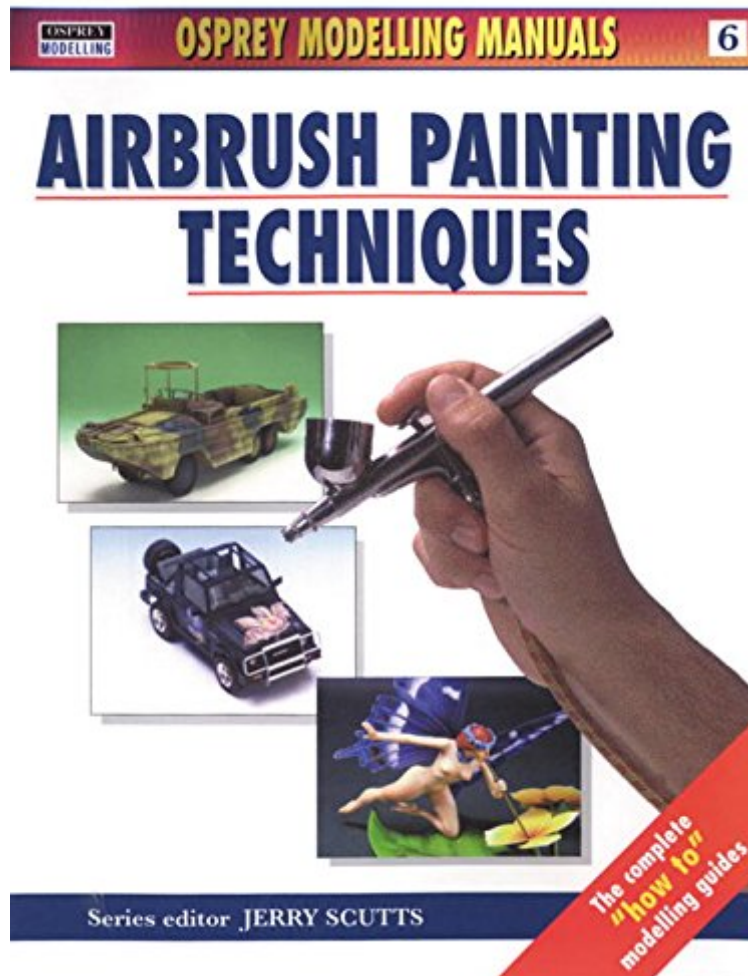

One chapter shows an airbrush being disassembled. Another is step-by-step on how to build your own silent compressor. One chapter has to do with mixing your own colors. The book seems to be more aim at general airbrush user instead of the scale model builder. I would have preferred more on thinning

paints and setting pressures. I do not recommend it. The Testor's manual on plastic model building is more useful. It has a great chapter on troubleshooting and how to tell if the paint is too thick or thin, or if the pressure is too high or too low. I think the Kalmbach Books' *Painting and Finishing Scale Models* is the best value on how to paint.
