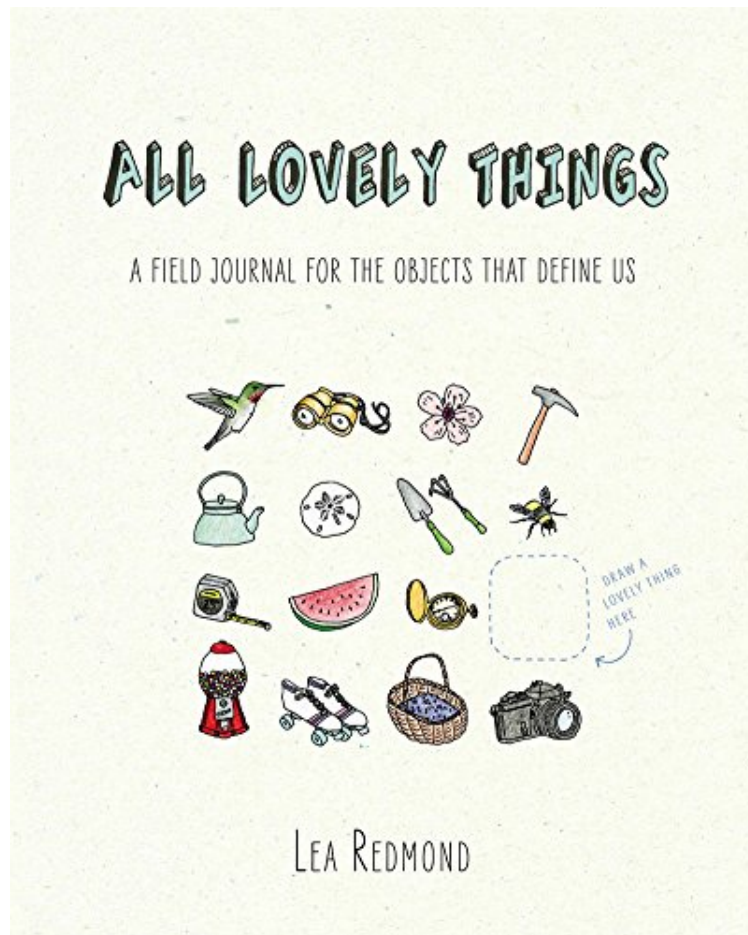

The book is filled with small frames with a single word prompt and includes examples to get you thinking. In the back theres a long list of additional prompts, in case you run out of ideas. I think this journal is a wonderful keepsake to have of my own life, as well as pass on to my children one day.

Think of this book as Pinterest for the inner soul. All Lovely Things asks readers to consider who they are by way of the diverse items they surround themselves with. Through simple, illustrated prompts, readers are encouraged to create object-based portraits of themselves, or people they know, admire, or imagine. Whether it's a favorite childhood toy, a piece of clothing worn on a first date, or a book that shaped who they are today, readers will create sketches, collage images, or record descriptions of the key objects in a life. They'll also find several completed portraits throughout for inspiration. Drawing attention to objects not as mere possessions or shallow stuff, but as fascinating companions in the world that help us develop a unique sense of self, All Lovely Things is a celebration of the way we make objects and how objects make us.
