By Jane in Milwaukee Margaret Boyles is a pretty prolific author and this book is unusual in that it's lifted mostly from another book by W. Ben Hunt and J.F. "Buck" Burshears (as it proclaims on the bottom of the cover): American Indian Beadwork (Beadwork Books). Here, though, the author focuses less on how to do Native American beadweaving and more to make needlepoint articles using such designs. Happily, the entire Chapter 7 of color drawings of beaded bands and large motifs from the first book is included in its entirety. At the end of the book where the author greatly expands on applying these designs to make mostly needlepoint pillows but also chokers and wall hangings. The designs are pretty and the charts and directions are easy to follow. I like this book.
