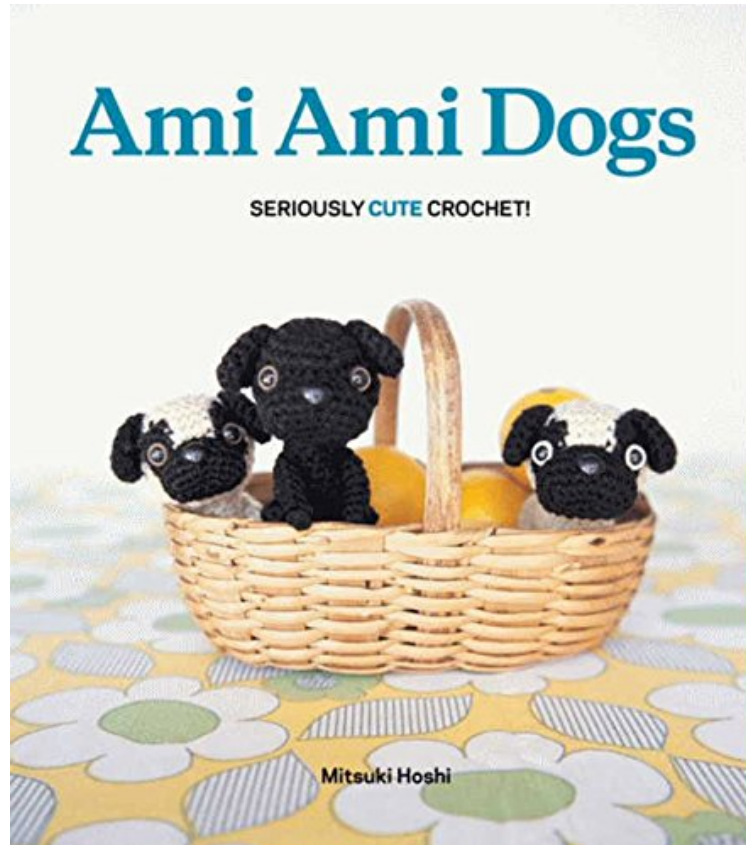

The color photos and instructions for creating the different stitches are very helpful, but they are arranged in a kind of strange way.I figured it out after staring at the pictures and the charts. It is more chart than instructions, so if you like following charts than this will be great for you. If you like clear written instructions then you may have a little trouble with the patterns.
