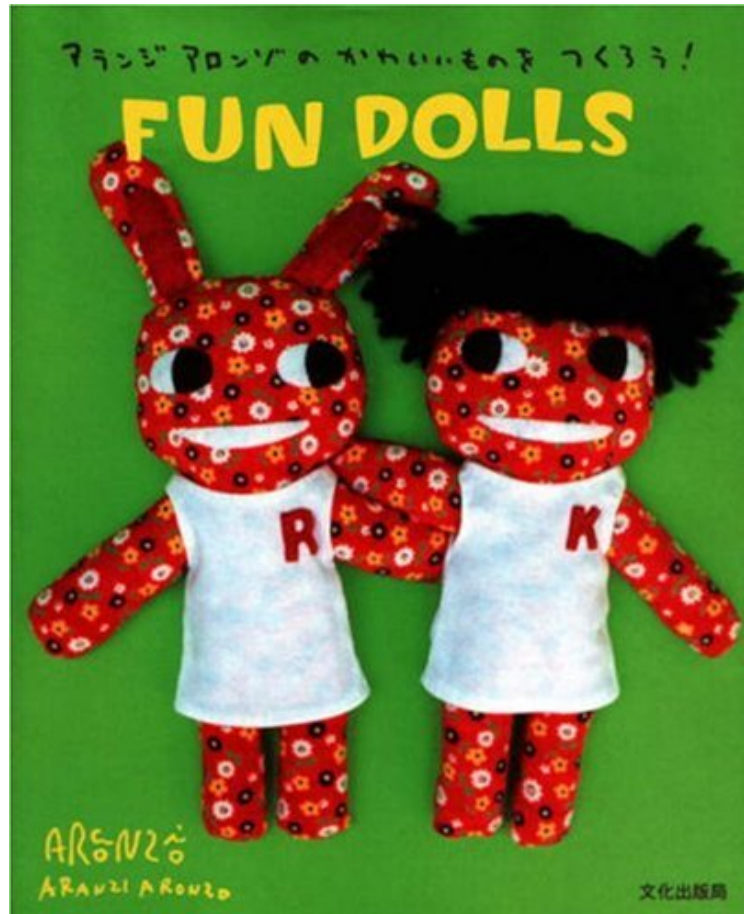

Cute Book hasn't arrived yet, so I can't vouch for it, but the other two are just so CUTE FUN, EASY odd, quirky, cool, weird, slightly dumb, just plain FUN! My 15 yr old 16 yr old daughters are making things out of them right now, even my 13 yr old son is looking (guardedly, can't be TOO thrilled about sewing....;-D) through the books, laughing, planning on making 2 or 3 things.
