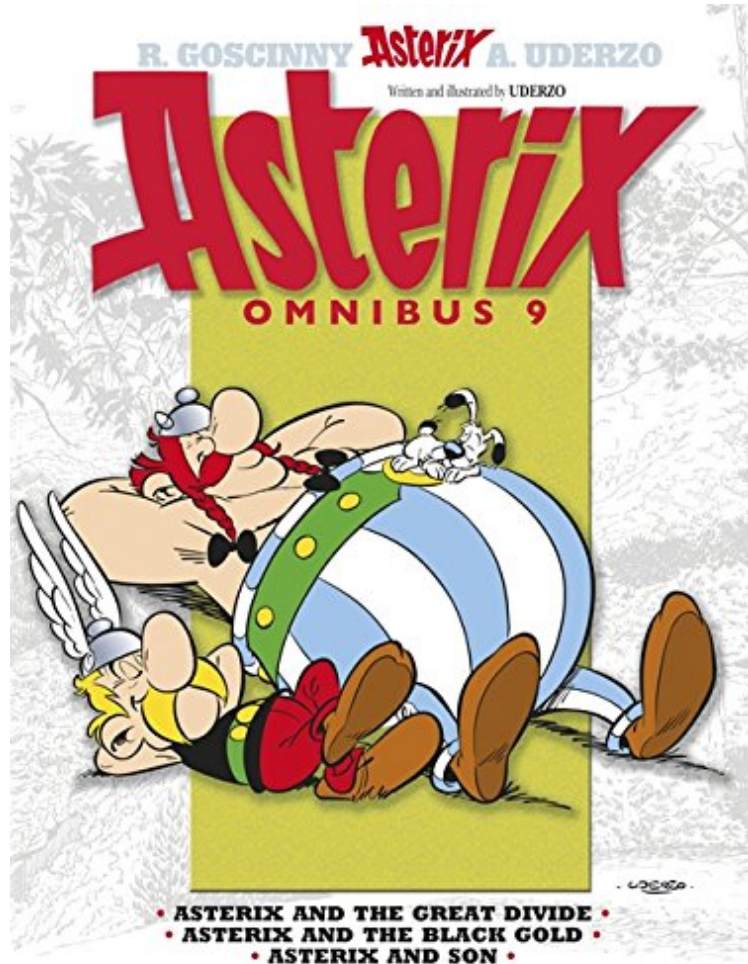

The heros of the stories are Asterix ( a short, but smart warrior) and his best friend Obelix ( a

large, boar meat loving, loyal but not smart warrior whom fell in a cauldron of magic potion as a child and as a result has permanent super strength). You can read each comic separately and be able to follow the story, though certain characters do repeat throughout the series. Albert Uderzo was born in 1927 in a small village in Marne, France. He met Rene Goscinny in 1951 and on 29 October 1959 their most famous creation, Asterix, made his first appearance on page 20 of **PILOTE**. **ASTERIX THE GAUL**, their first album, was published in 1961 and there have now been 35 Asterix albums.
