It measures 9.25 by 12.25 inches and is sewn into a matte finish cover with foil accents. Featuring birds and botanicals, this book is appropriate for adult colorists on all skill levels.Paper:The paper in this book is cream colored and about twice the thickness of standard copy weight. All pages are double sided and non-perforated. Dry mediums are okay to use, but wet products may bleed through and ruin the backside of your picture. As always, be sure to place several sheets of blotter paper under your page to prevent any color transfer.Artwork:As the title suggests, "Birdtopia" features a wide variety of avian life- as well as woodland creatures and botanicals. Inside you'll see hummingbirds, eagles, sparrows, foxes, gazelles, deer, and more. Some of the pages feature a single image, while others include a full background and

foreground. There are 5 pages of artwork that have been mostly pre-colored, and a few single colored elements scattered throughout the rest of the book. There is a fairly even split between double and single page images, and there is a bit of grayscale included as well. Much of the artwork does continue into the binding, so removing pages isn't advisable. Detail level is fairly high and picture completion time should range from 2-10 hours(may be slightly different for each individual). Overall, this is a stunning book with beautifully done artwork. It would be best suited for chalk/pencil colorists who enjoy vintage/nature inspired imagery. 26 of 26 people found the following review helpful.
