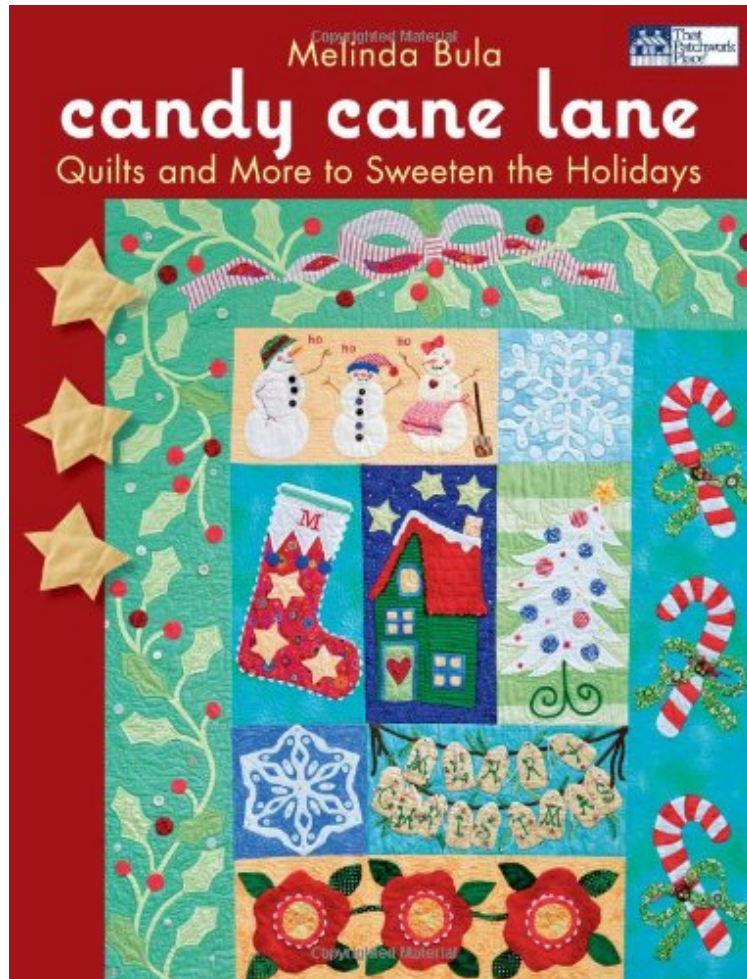

The book includes basic information on fusible-web and needle-turn applique, as well as full-size pull-out templates for all of the applique patterns. "Candy Cane Lane" is the sampler quilt on the cover. Melinda used needle-turn applique for this quilt, but she also includes instructions for fusible web applique, as well as instructions for embellishments and embroidery. This book really gets me in the mood for Christmas with its cheery, colorful projects. In addition to complete instructions for the sampler quilt, there are smaller projects that you can make using the motifs from the lap quilt, like whimsical Christmas stockings and a wall hanging with removable pockets for treats for the little ones (and maybe the grown-ups, too!). Melinda shares a sweet Christmas memory about a wall hanging like this that her mom made. The snowflake pillows are adorable, but my favorite is the Candy Cane Table Runner. Yo-yos make such a nice decorative border along the edge. I hope you enjoy the pictures as much as I have. Brent Kane is the photographer and he, too, is an amazing artist.
